Slax6.0 (Slackware 12) LiveCD w EPICS

LiveEPICS (© copyright under GNU General Public License) is a bootable USB/CD Linux distribution, which contains a pre-configured EPICS development environment. After booting, the user can access all the utilities required to create a simple control application.

All the Epics software (sources and built) is placed into */opt* folder:

- base-3.14.10 (default)
- base-3.14.9
- Extensions: StripTool 2.5.12.0, ALH 1.2.23, MEDM 3.1.2.1, Probe, msi 1.4, VDCT
- Modules: Asyn 4.10 (default), Asyn 4.9, Asyn 4.8, Auto Save, ProcServer 2.4.0

Other software:

- Nagios 3.03 compiled and setup to monitor the classical dummy "example" application
- Apache 2.2.9, Firefox, Skype, K3B, Kopete, Kword, Kspread, Kpresenter, GSlapt (like a graphical apt-get of Debian), Slack Konfigurator, Slack Module Creator, KDE 3.5

How to configure network

LiveEPICS uses DHCP to autoconfigure your network card's IP address, route tables and nameservers. If you are on the network with DHCP server then you shouldn't have any problem. Just boot LiveEPICS and everything will work.
